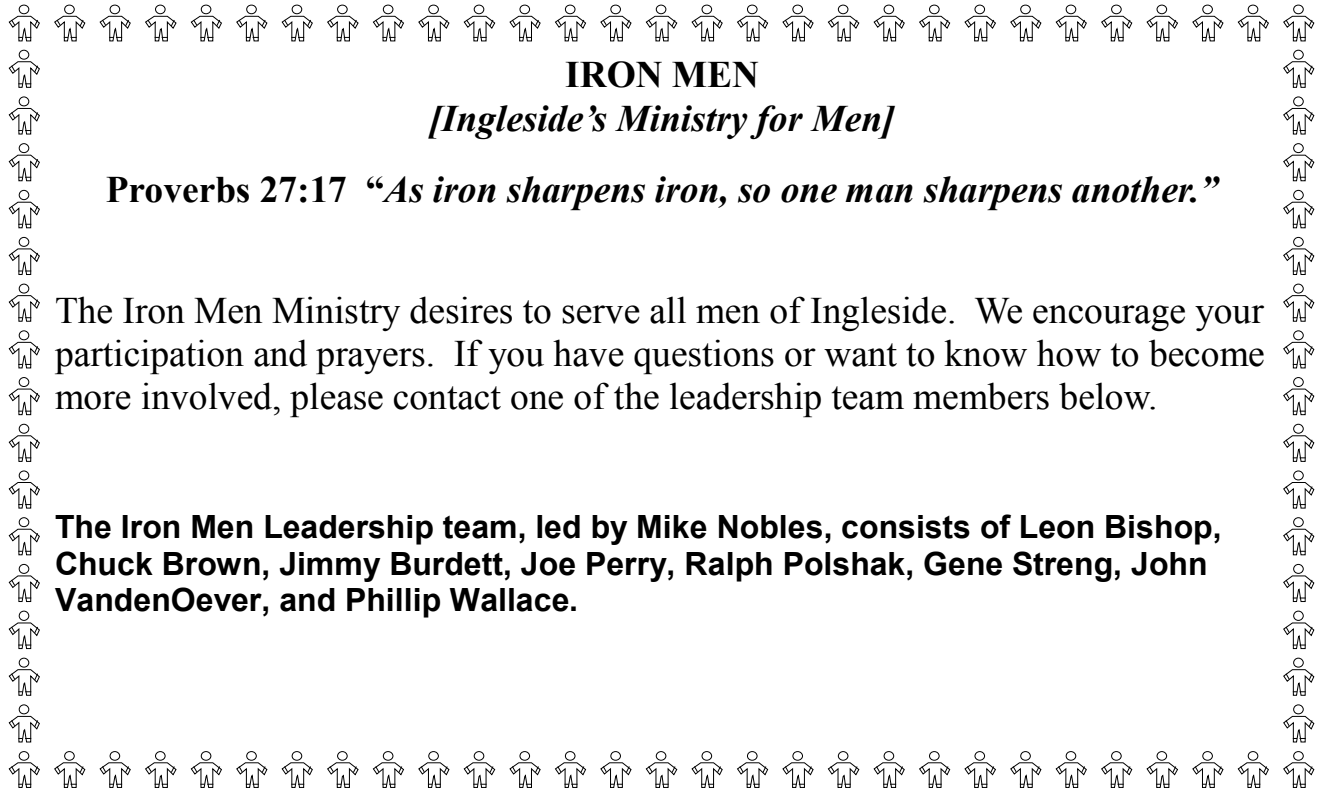

The Ushering Captain for November is Jimmy Burdett. If you have any special needs or questions, please contact him. If you are on the team, please let him know if you are unavailable for any service.

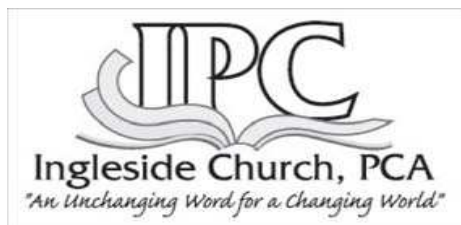
