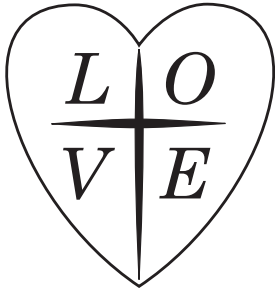

Dear Church Family,

I referred to Acts 2:46-47 in January 31st's message: "And day by day, attending the temple together & breaking bread in their homes, they received their food with glad & generous hearts, praising God & having favor with all the people. IPC Missions Conference Set For March 5th – 10th

In Acts chapter 1 before Jesus was taken from his disciples and returned to heaven he said “you shall be my witnesses both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea and Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth.” Ingleside supports more than 30 ministry organizations through the missions department that are doing just that. They are preaching the good news of the gospel in our local Judea, our national Samaria and to the rest of the earth. This year IPC’s missions conference is scheduled for March 6th-10th. During that time you will have the opportunity to be exposed to people who are engaged in foreign missions around the world, national missions in the United States and local missions in Gwinnett and Georgia. Please consider coming out for as many of the programs as you can attend. Yes, even if you have other normal conflicts this could be a time to postpone that club meeting, or miss that sports practice or not attend that music lesson. Come out and bring your kids. See for yourself how God is moving across the world. Consider how God would have you participate in that through, prayer, finances, ministry or missions. This is an important even that everyone at IPC could benefit from.

The conference will begin on Friday March 5th with a dinner for the diaconate and the session with Pastor Brian Deringer the conferences keynote speaker. On Saturday morning March 6th the men will gather and have breakfast and hear from several missionaries who will tell about their ministries and challenges. During the meeting we will pray for their specific needs. On Sunday March 7th Brian Deringer will speak in the morning service. Additional missionary speakers will be on hand to share about their ministries in a special evening sandwich supper

which will begin at 5:45pm that evening. On Monday the 8th at 7:00pm will be movie night. Two movies with missions themes will be shown – one for adults and the other for children. On Tuesday the 9th home fellowship groups will host a dessert fellowship at the church that will feature several missions speakers. The conference will close on Oasis Wednesday night March 10th at 5:45pm. There will be our normal supper together followed by a closing missions program featuring Brian Deringer and others. Please, make this conference a priority and come out and support as many of the activities and events as possible.

Another ministry opportunity that is available for each of us to consider is the Minutemen. Minutemen for Missions is a ministry of compassionate response to urgent human suffering, administered through the PCA’s Mission to the World. The Minutemen are a group of people who commit themselves to support through prayer and giving. The Ingleside Missions Committee has committed to become a part of this ministry.

The Minutemen stand ready to send \$5.00 or more, up to four times a year, as they are notified. Gifts sent to MTW from the Minutemen are used by missionaries to minister God’s compassion to suffering people around the world. Gifts in the past have benefited the tsunami victims in SE Asia, hurricane relief efforts in Louisiana, Mexico and the Caribbean and earthquake relief in Haiti, Pakistan and Iran and famine relief in Ethiopia.
