Dear Church Family,

Holy Week will be almost starting by the time you receive this edition of the church newsletter, meaning Easter is only days away. And it is relatively early this year. We will have our regular worship schedule that day and would like to encourage as many folks who can to attend first worship on Easter Sunday, since we anticipate a number of guests that day at both services. Also, I want to encourage our more mobile folks to park across the street at Crews School that day, to allow ample parking in our lot for guests. The choir has planned special music and I hope to have a sermon of hope and encouragement for the triumphant holiday. Maybe you could invite a friend or neighbor to worship that day. Easter is one Sunday where typically unchurched people may be more open to attend.

After seeking guidance from the elders, we have decided to postpone the Church-wide Family Retreat that had been slated at Ridge Haven on April 23rd-25th. The decision was based on low numbers and a number of our folks had scheduling conflicts with the weekend. Our men's ministry is planning a retreat in the Fall, so we will plan another family retreat for calendar year 2011. I so appreciate the folks who promptly signed up for this retreat.

However, the first weekend of May will be a celebration of the 110th Anniversary of Ingleside's existence as a church. IPC was organized in May 1900 in unincorporated Scottdale in DeKalb County. On Saturday, May 1st, we will hold a church-wide picnic on our campus. We will be asking everyone to bring food and serving tables will be set up in the fellowship hall and we'll eat inside and outside of the building. Please bring lawn chairs or blankets if you're eating outside. We will also have field event games for ALL ages on the property near the youth house. The time and details will be announced by our Fellowship Team, under the leadership of Rick Jarvis and Craig Bland, in the very near future. We will celebrate and recognize this 110th year milestone during both worship services on May 2nd. God has truly been good to Christ's Church at Ingleside!

The topic is **STUDYING GOD'S WORD. The Bible as God's Word; its place in our lives.** (Room 5 on the terrace level)
