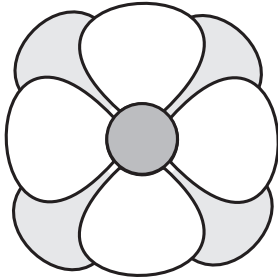

### Dear Church Family,

I trust that none of you married folks have ever forgotten a special event, like your anniversary or your spouse's birthday. Our church family is celebrating the 110th Anniversary of Ingleside's being a visible church. The official observance is Saturday, May 1st, with an old-fashioned picnic and field day games, beginning at noon. On May 2nd, there will be special anniversary recognitions during both morning worship hours. There were only a couple of dozen charter members, but Mac Dorton's maternal grandparents were two of them and his grandfather served on the first Session of Ingleside. Over the years Ingleside has been served by twenty-five pastors and three assistant/associate pastors. The church has ministered in Scottsdale, Stone Mountain and Lawrenceville during her 110 year history. Our current communing membership is nearing 300 and we number above 300 when you count our non-communing children of Ingleside.

When Rachel and I arrived with our family to Ingleside in 1993, it didn't take us long to realize that Ingleside is truly a family to so many of our members. The church has filled in a void that some have had because their biological family wasn't in good "working order." Others, geographically separated from their extended families have found surrogate parents and grandparents from among our church folks. For many, Ingleside is home as long as they reside on this earth.

As we look ahead there is a diverse community living around us. We are becoming increasingly aware of homelessness in our county and what we may be able to do—helping one family at a time. Jesus told His followers that the fields are "white unto harvest." Ingleside has a mission field that is global in nature as we support numerous missionaries around the world. But our mission field is also on Old Snellville Highway and to the surrounding communities. I trust that we will commit to selflessly give of our time, talents and financial resources to be the hands and feet of Jesus in the world at large—and the world right next door. Happy Anniversary, everyone!
